- 10.15 Play time
- 10.30 Circle time
- 10.40- Maths based activities
- 11.45 story
- 12.00- Lunch
- 1.00- Afternoon input and activities to follow
- 3.00- story time
- 3.20 Children are dismissed for home

Phonics

- ► In school we use 'Little Wandle Phonics'
- ▶ Reception will start phonic lessons after being in school for 2 weeks.
- Children will be taught the sounds that letters make and learn how to blend and segment them for writing
- Phonics is taught daily and children will be sent home with reading books which match their phonic ability.
- Little book of sounds children will bring home their 'little book of sounds' which will have simple letter formations of the letters and sounds they have learnt in class.
- Tricky words some words are classed as tricky as they cannot be sounded out.
