38% of the small cohort of pupils achieved the expected standard in reading, writing & maths in 2017. This is not reflective of previous attainment.

80% of children attained a good level of development compared with 69% nationally in 2016.

Year 1 Phonics check 2017 (11 pupils)

90% of the 11 Y1 pupils reached the expected level in Y1 Phonics check compared to 81% Nationally in 2016.

84% of eligible pupils have now achieved this benchmark.
