Congratulations Year 6

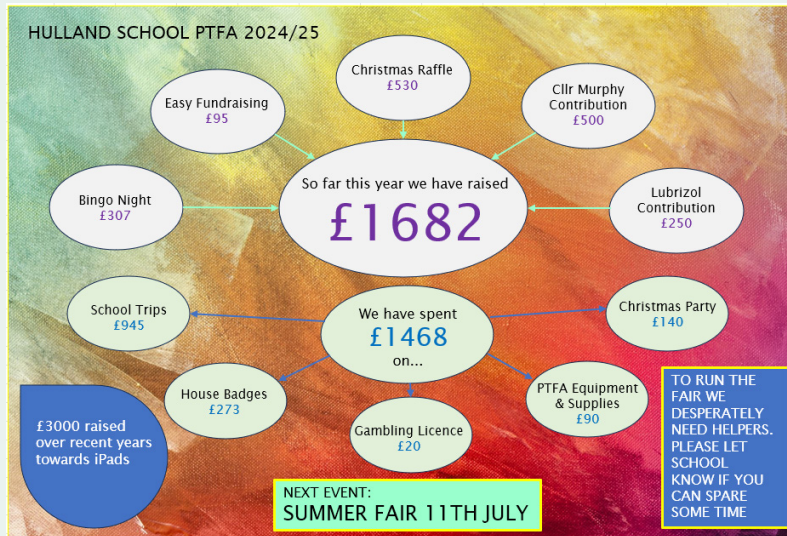
